The book also addresses both the scientific board (al-hay'ah al-'ilmiyyah) and general teaching systems in al-Masjid al-Harām, as well as the most renowned courtyards (sing. haswah) and arcades (sing. riwāq), where study circles were convened. The book concludes with biographies (tarājim) of scholars of the two holy mosques.







The letters were written in very eventful times as there were many attempts to overthrow the Ottoman rule in the Arabian Peninsula, such as the capture of Najd, Iḥsa' and Qaṭīf by Sa'ūd al-Faiṣal. This led to a noticeable increase in the volume of correspondence between the High Porte and the Wālī of Ḥijāz whereby his views on the political developments were consulted, the preparation of a local army was discussed and the attempts to consolidate and draw in the Arab tribes were followed through. The correspondence also included general supervision details of the two cities of Makkah and Madinah.







The book aims to trace back and document the beginnings of the book manufacture in the region of the Hijāz since the time of the Prophet and the Caliphate.

The author recollects the historic developments that occurred during the prophetic and caliphate periods through identifying that period's documents in major sources. He captures the initial moments of archiving as well as the factors that influenced its development, including the education system and authorship, the codification of the Qur'ān, and the political, legal and monetary factors of the time. In the second chapter the author looks at the initial stages of book making, the materials involved, the terminology used to describe them, the ways and means of preserving documents as well as the scribes of that time. This study resulted in the establishment of the first library on the Islamic civilisation and the setting up of the first publishing house for the Qur'ān. The author also found documents pertinent to the influence of Persian book makers on the Arabs. He describes a number of the early centres for the production of the Qur'ān (maṣāhif). He also found evidence to demonstrate the establishment of Qur'ānic schools (katātīb) and administrative departments (dawāwīn) at the time of the Prophet.
